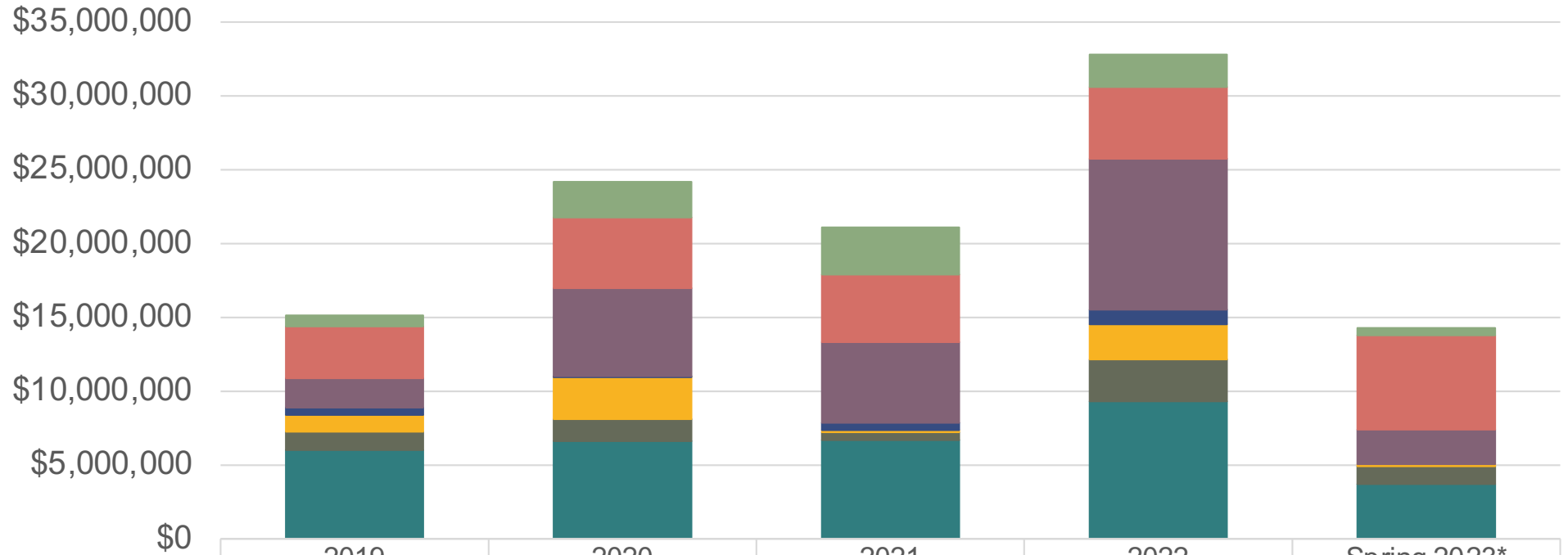


Longwood Foundation Grants Awarded by Program Area, 2019-Spring 2023
